Fact sheet: Cantonal allocations of persons with protection status S

Basics

- Persons who apply for asylum or protection in Switzerland are allocated to the cantons in proportion to the size
 of the canton's population once their application has been examined and a decision has been made. The cantons have agreed on this allocation key.
- Not included in the cantonal allocation figures below are:
 - o Persons who have not submitted an application for protection status S, but who reside in a canton;
 - Persons who have registered via the 'RegisterMe' web portal, are resident in a canton and whose application has not yet been processed.

The figures below may therefore differ from the number of persons actually in the cantons.

- · Nominal allocation: Number of protection seekers who would should be allocated to a canton according to the allocation key.
