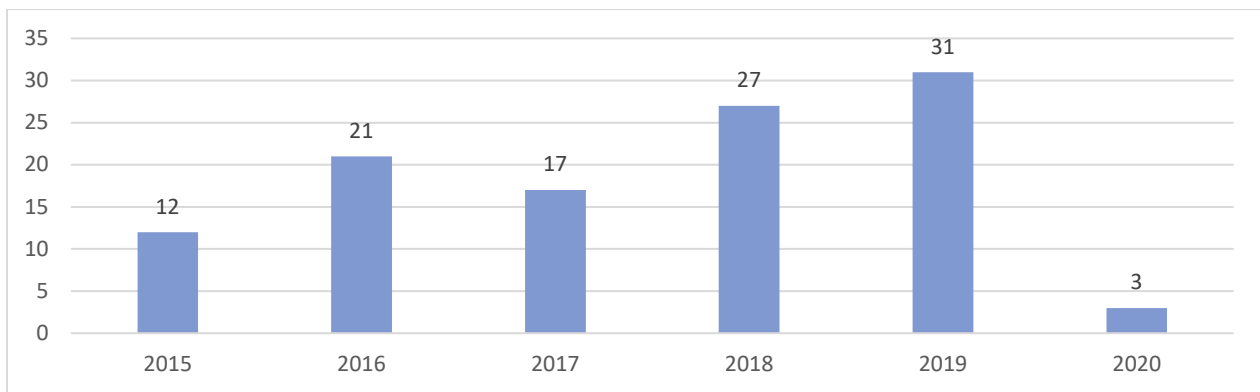




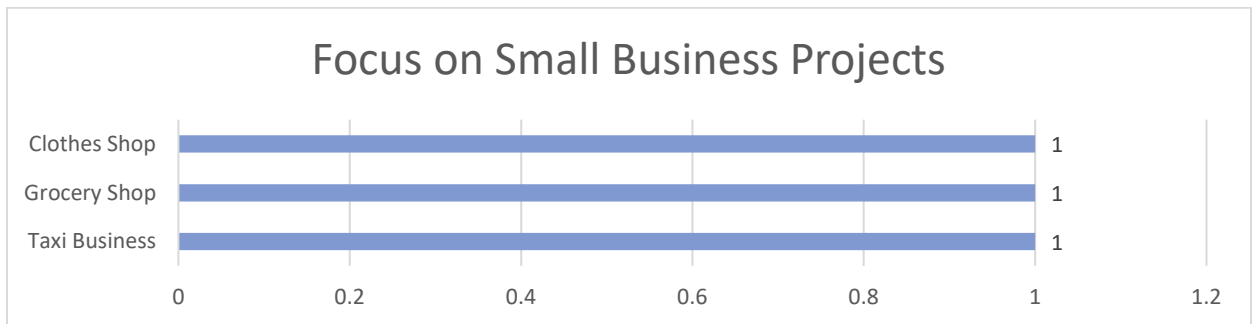
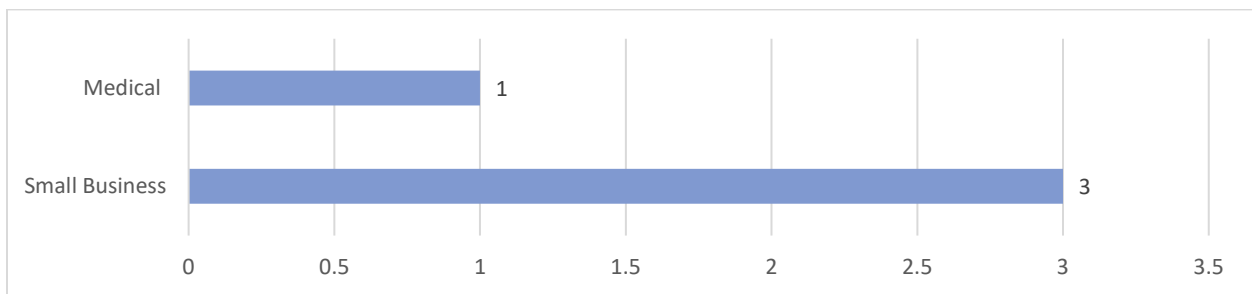
Reintegration Assistance – Flat Funding 2020 – Sri Lanka

- **Implementation support for 3 reintegration projects** in 2020 (for a total of USD 9'691 - **2 male beneficiaries** and **1 female beneficiary**)
- **Return operations for 4 cases** (3 men and 1 woman, no children)
- IOM Sri Lanka was supported through a **Swiss flat funding** of USD 45'899 in 2020
- No **Business Training** could be conducted in 2020 due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

Reintegration Cases from 2015 to 2020



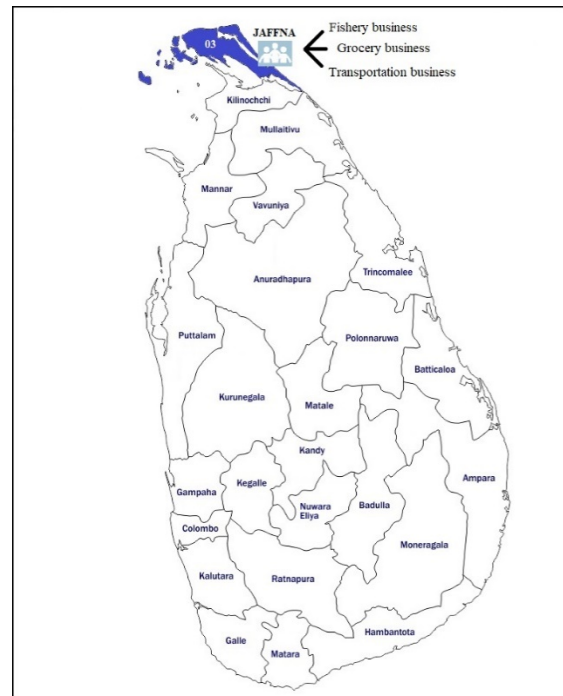
Reintegration Projects in 2020





Business Training Results

- While business training activities for migrants returning from Switzerland in 2020 were planned, these could not be implemented due to the Covid-19 pandemic.
- Generally, the number of migrants returning to Sri Lanka from Switzerland in 2020 was extremely low due to Covid-19 related restrictions as well as a lack of flights to the country.
- Unused funds from 2020 will be therefore used to implement business training activities in 2021. All beneficiaries who returned in 2020 will also have access to these activities.
- The graphic on the right showcases the **geographic distribution** of Swiss reintegration mandates in Sri Lanka.
- All beneficiaries in 2020 returned to **Jaffna**, in north Sri Lanka.
- The activities include individual reintegration projects in the fields of accommodation, agriculture, animal husbandry and fishing.
